

Summer Recruit Training Packing List

- 2 plain Black Sweat pants to put over shorts in the evenings
- * 6 plain black shorts (no stripes, no color logo, no short shorts or spandex)
- 6 plain Grey t-shirts (no v neck, no pockets)
- 1 plain Black Sweatshirt, no hood or logos
- 2 Pairs of dark blue jeans (no holes, no decorations)
- 10 pairs of white socks
- 10 pairs of underwear
- 2 Sports bras
- 2-3 Shower Towels
- 1 black belt
- Hygiene products (Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Hair brush, Hair ties, chapstick) – must be in a sealed plastic baggie.
- 1 Pair of tennis shoes/running shoes
- Full sized notebook
- 2 Pens AND 2 Pencils
- Camel Back (Water Backpack)
- Sleeping Bag (Rated for current weather)
- Black trash bag to put dirty clothes in!
- Pillow(s)
- Shower Shoes (Flip Flops, Sandals, etc.)!!!
- 1-2 Flashlights and extra Batteries
- Bug spray
- Sunscreen

If your child has medication they need to take please bring it in a ziploc bag with their name on it. In the ziploc bag also include a piece of paper with detailed instructions for taking the medication. All medications will be kept by adult staff and handed out as needed, with the exception of inhalers.

Please do not bring any tobacco, alcohol, drugs, pogy bait (snacks or drinks besides water), fire starters (matches, lighters, etc), electronics (cell phones, music players, tablets, etc), or weapons (knives, guns, explosives, etc). If your child brings any of the items mentioned above, they will be immediately asked to leave, NO EXCEPTIONS. Everything that they bring will be searched, so make sure not to bring any of it.

SHARP. Show up in a grey shirt, sweatshirt, and sweat pants, and running shoes with a MARKED camelback that is full of water. Grey shirts should ALWAYS be tucked into your sweats. Please bring everything mentioned above neatly packed in a suitcase, or duffel bag. Everything that you bring with you needs to be marked with your last name, so you don't lose it. If you are late, the gates will be shut, and will not be reopened.

FEMALES

Please arrive at boot camp with your hair in a ponytail or bun. Fingernails should be free of any color nail polish, and artificial nails. Do not bring nail polish or make up with you, because it is not part of the grooming standards. If applicable, please bring sanitary napkins. You may wear small post earrings; no other jewelry is allowed, with the exception of religious jewelry. Do not show up at boot camp with any make-up on your face, or with you. If you do, you will immediately be asked to go wash your face.

MALES

Please arrive at boot camp with a proper haircut. If you do not, one will be provided for you at boot camp. This free haircut may not be to your liking, so please arrive in compliance with the grooming standards of the Young Marines.
